Print off your scale cards, preferably onto the thickest card your printer can take.</li> <li>2. Cut out the cards.</li> <li>3. Separate the cards into two piles. One pile of chords, the other of scales.</li> </ol> <p>www.chrishopgood.co.uk</p>
<p><b>Instructions</b></p> <p><b>Chords</b></p> <p>Shuffle the pile of chord cards and place them face down in front of you.</p> <p>Take the top 6 cards from the deck and place them face up in front of you.</p> <p>This is your chord sequence. Play the chords in the sequence they have appeared.</p> <p>www.chrishopgood.co.uk</p>	<p><b>Instructions</b></p> <p><b>Chords cont..</b></p> <p>If possible, use a metronome or a drum sequence to play the chord sequence too.</p> <p>You should have received two mp3 drum sequences with these cards.</p> <p>Strum each chord for 4 beats.</p> <p>www.chrishopgood.co.uk</p>	<p><b>Instructions</b></p> <p><b>Scales</b></p> <p>Shuffle the pile of scale cards and place them face down in front of you.</p> <p>Take the top card from the deck and place it face up in front of you.</p> <p>Play the scale shown.</p> <p>www.chrishopgood.co.uk</p>
